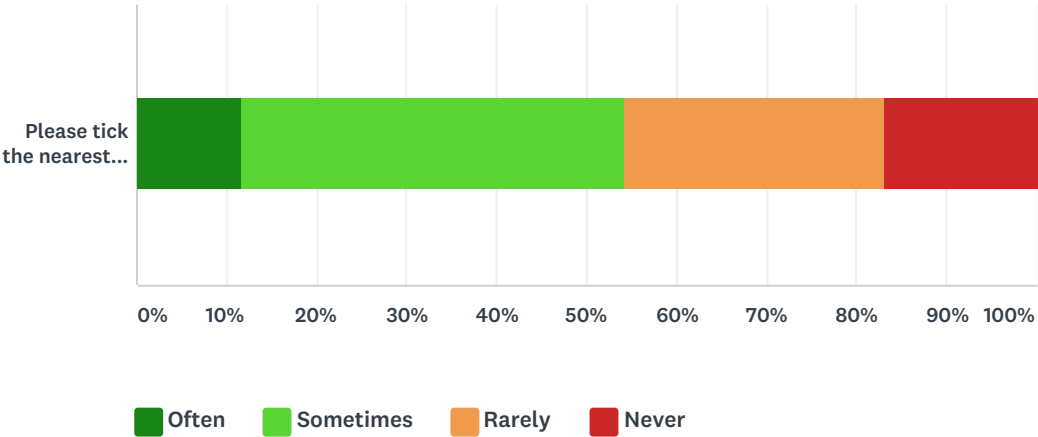

Q8 How would you feel if this policy were to change to allow more homes/small developments to be built in the parish?

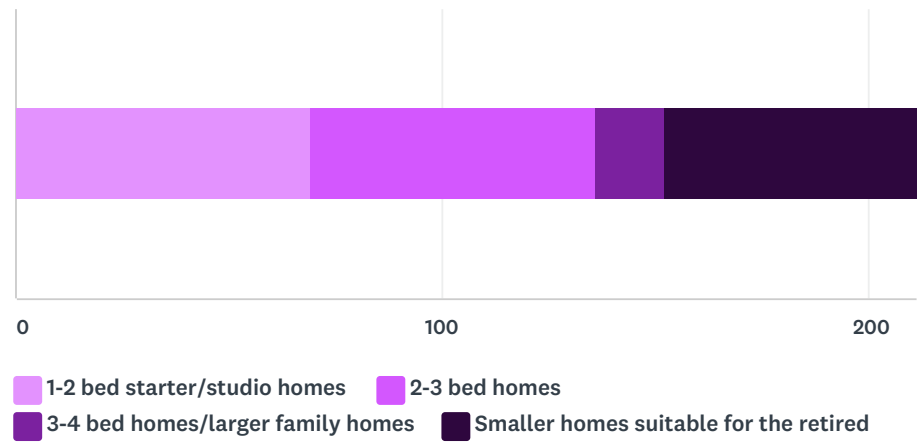

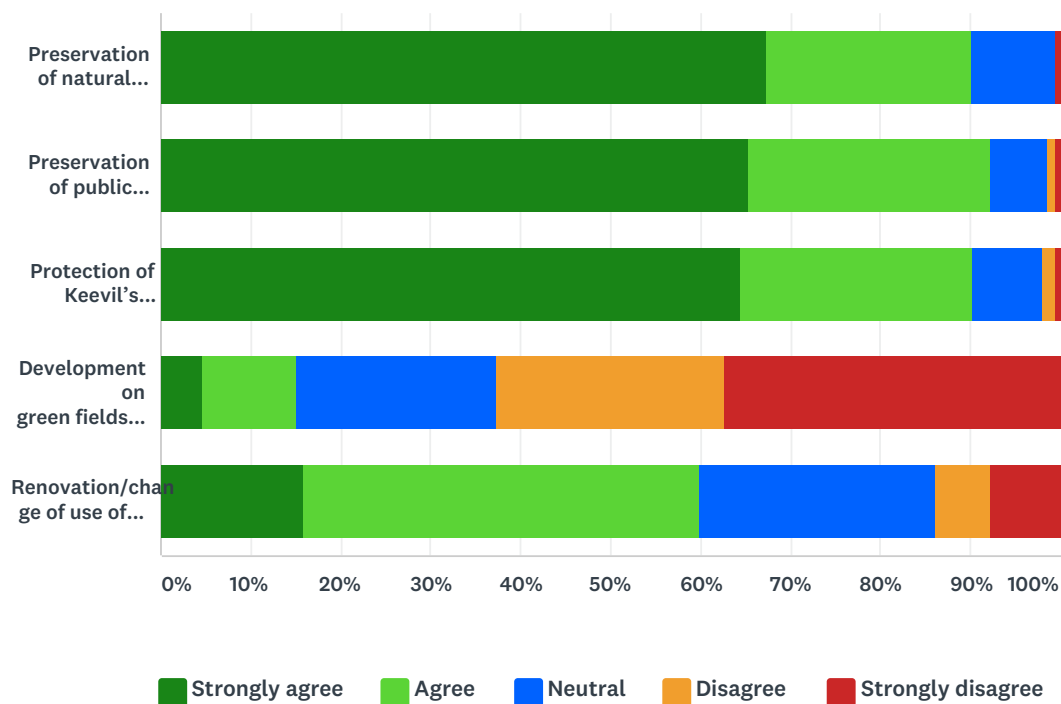

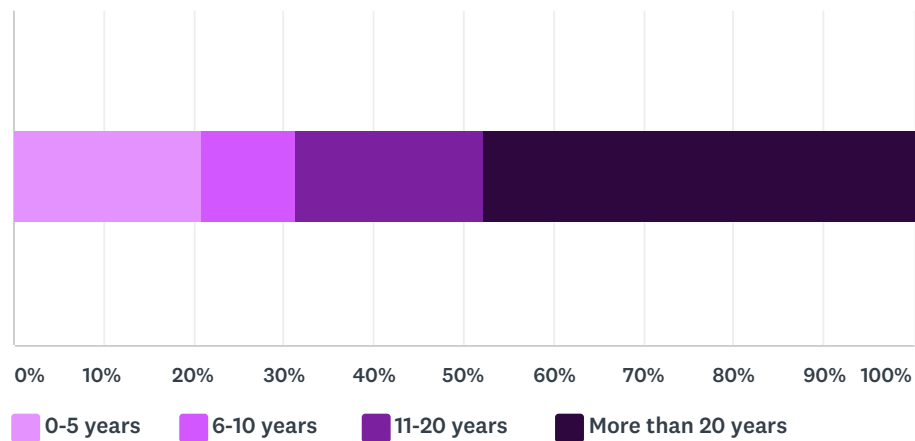

Q20 How long have you lived in Keevil?

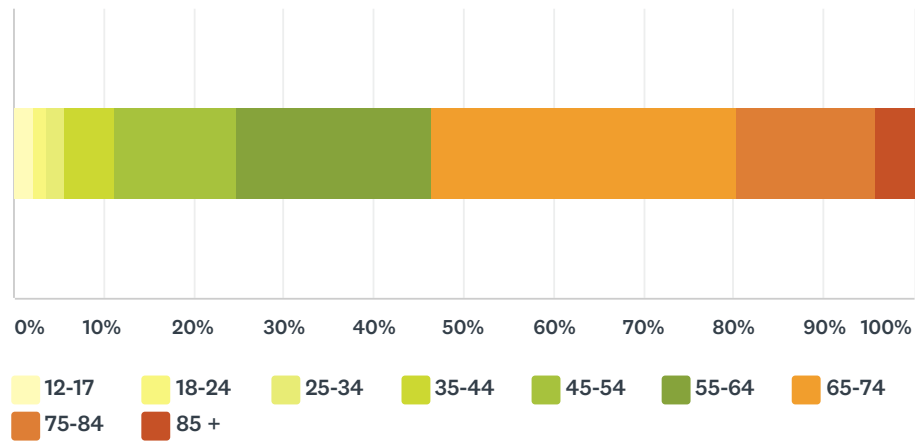

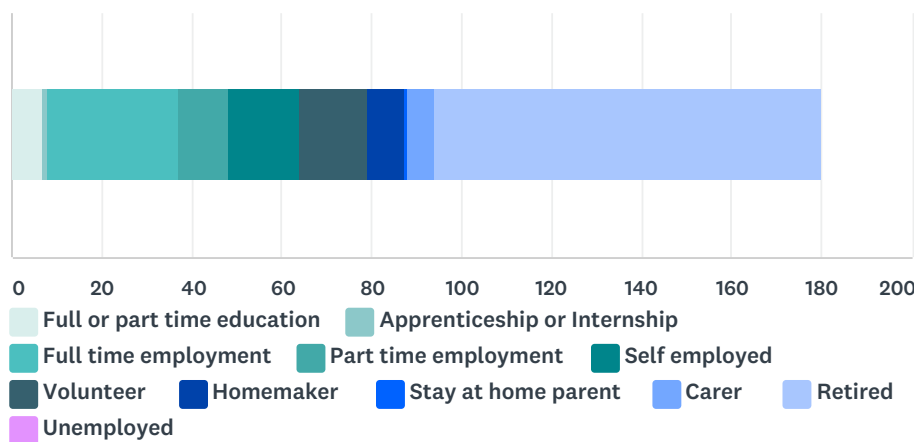

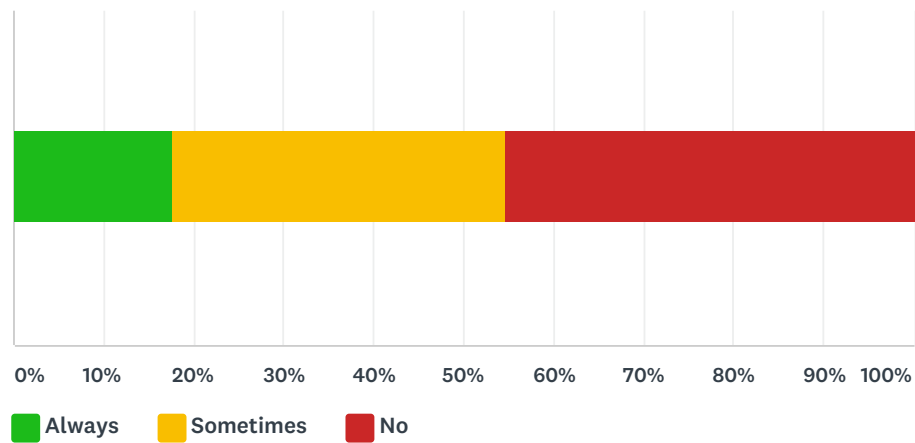

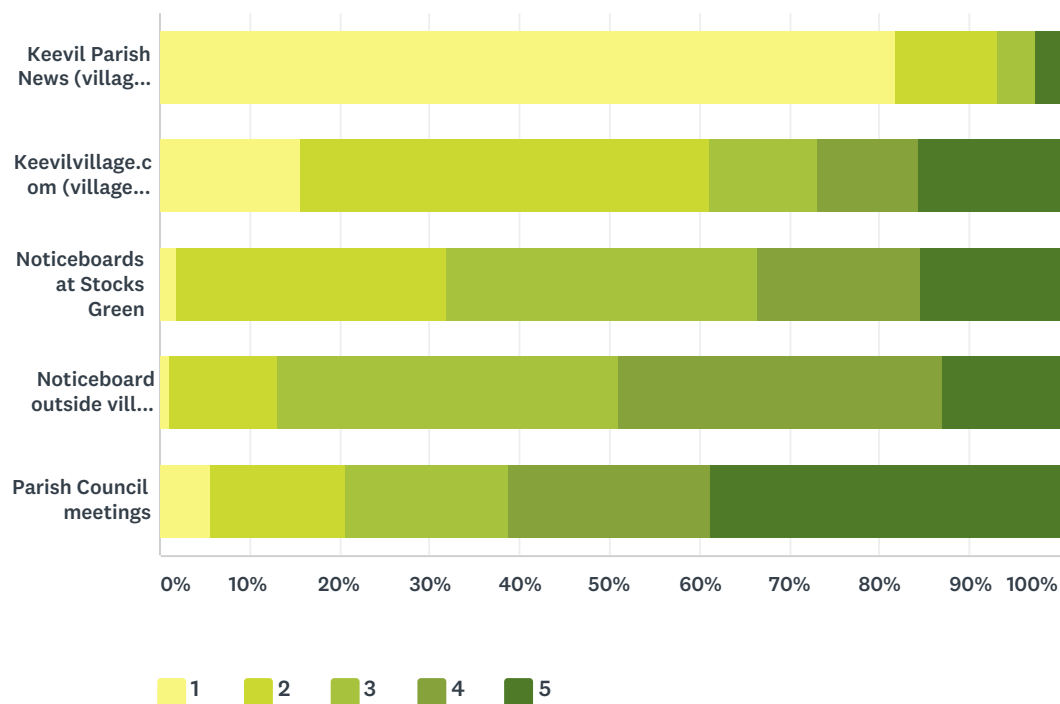

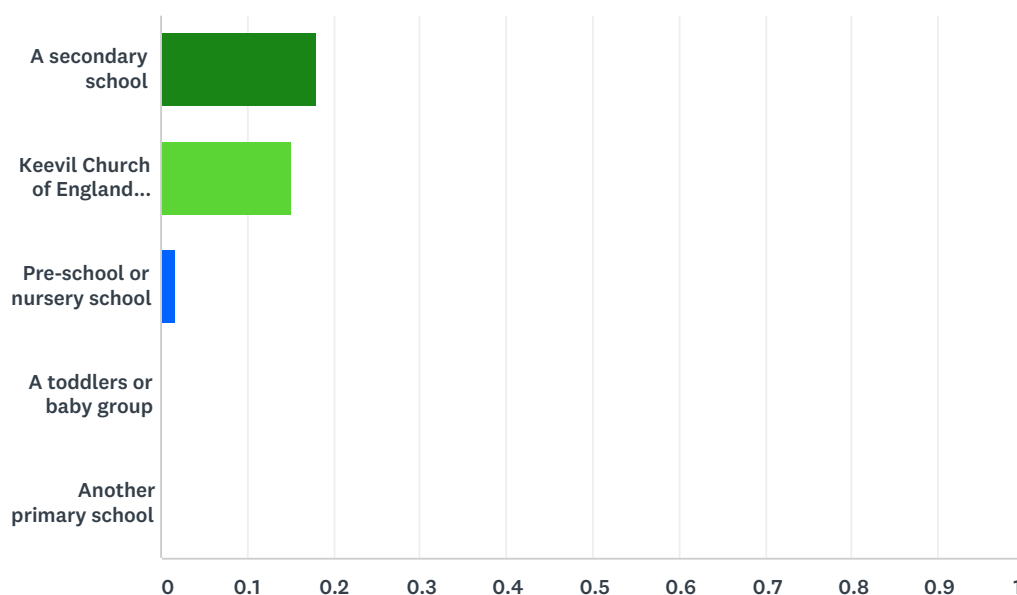

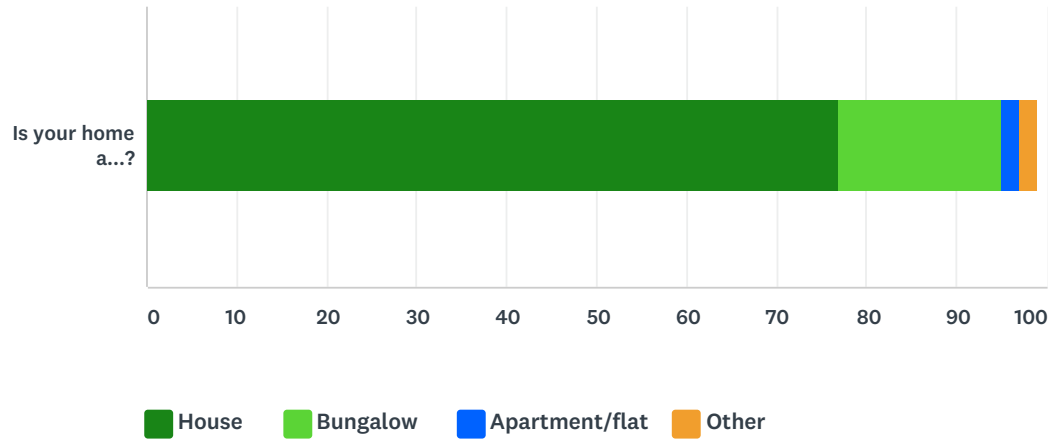
